

A very happy Easter to you once again! I hope you've all duly recovered from your celebrations and that you've enjoyed your extended Easter weekend. It was lovely to see you all in the church over the Holy Week! Easter Sunday was very busy, with a good number at the Paschal Vigil and a completely packed church her at the 11am Mass – a great sight indeed.



A big thank you to everybody who has in any way helped to prepare for the Holy Week and Easter liturgies in so many different ways visually, audibly or otherwise! Many have commented how beautiful the church and the liturgies were, which is always very encouraging to hear. A big shout out to our servers whose help is so key! Divine Mercy Sunday – Low Sunday is also referred to as Divine Mercy Sunday. Today also concludes the Octave of Easter. Simply speaking, Divine Mercy is another name for the magnificent love of God, which culminates in Jesus' life, death and resurrection that we have just celebrated. The name also refers to the devotion to Divine Mercy, which was started by a polish nun Sister Faustina after Christ appeared to her on several occasions. St John Paul II, at the Mass of Canonisation of now St Faustina, spoke these words: "Divine Mercy reaches human beings from the Heart of Christ crucified. Today, fixing our gaze with you on the face of the Risen Christ, let us make our own your prayer of trusting abandonment and say with firm hope: 'Jesus, I trust in You!'"

Good Friday Collection – This Sunday we are having a delayed collection which supports the Patriarchate of Jerusalem in the upkeep of the Holy Places in the Holy Land. This is especially pertinent at this difficult time.

Please pray for baby Elaiza Reinikovas who is being baptised after the 11am Mass this Sunday. Please also keep her mom and dad in your prayers.

Easter Water – The Holy Water blessed at the Easter Vigil is available at the back the back of the church.

Easter in Prison – Please pray for the prisoners in HMP Oakwood and Brinsford. On Friday Fr Tomas was in Oakwood to celebrate the sacrament of baptism for one of the prisoners who has been preparing for this moment for some time.
