**Graveyard Safety** Following a Health & Safety review we are looking at the safety of the grave stones in our grave yard. You will have noticed that some of the grave stones have red tape around them indicating that they could be unsafe. If one of the taped grave stones belongs to a family member or a family that you know can you please contact the parish office as soon as possible & let us know what the stone mason intends to do to make the grave stone safe. If we do not hear from anyone regarding the grave by the end of October 2018 the stone will be laid flat to prevent it falling over. Thank you for your help with this matter.

Archbishop Bernard Longley has commissioned a review of our current safeguarding/child protection practices in light of the National Catholic Policies & Procedures. This review is to be welcomed as a means of ensuring that our systems to protect our children & young people are as effective as possible. This review is being conducted by an independent charity called SCIE (Social Care Institute for Excellence). As part of the review, SCIE would like to speak with any individuals who have had experience with any safeguarding issues within the Archdiocese, & have experience of working with our parish safeguarding representatives & the safeguarding team at the Archdiocese.
