I found out this week that I had been in contact with someone who has since tested positive for Covid-19. Although I have tested negative, I still have to self-isolate until Monday. We are grateful for Canon Michael and Fr Simon from St Austin's, Stafford, for celebrating our Sunday Masses at St Mary's today.

We had the sad news this week that Michael Bates has passed away. Michael did so much to serve at the altar at St Mary's and to host amazing social evenings; impressing us with his cooking skills and repartee. Last November, Michael received a *Ubi Caritas* award from Archbishop Bernard for service in the Church (see right). We are grateful for all Michael did to serve our community and we keep him and his family in our prayers at this difficult time.



Michael's funeral will be at St Mary's on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> July at 10.30am but please be advised that our Covid-secure limit in church is 64 people so not all who wish to come may be able to be accommodated. The funeral will be live-streamed on the parish YouTube site given opposite for those who cannot attend on the day.

Some of our young people will receive their First Holy Communion next Saturday afternoon. Unfortunately, due to Covid restrictions, only those families who have been invited may attend this Mass, but I'm sure it will be a lovely day and we keep our candidates in our prayers.
