Live-Streaming at St Mary's We now have a camera installed at St Marys' church and so all Masses and other services are being live-streamed. You can watch on the parish's **new YouTube channel** at: www.youtube.com/watch?v=hukZyKzXn20&feature=youtu.be ***Please note the change from Fr Paul's YouTube channel which will not be used for parish Masses after this weekend. See overleaf for parts of the Mass and for a **Prayer of Spiritual Communion**. The camera in church focuses on the altar and just below (where Holy Communion is received) so those attending Mass will not generally be seen on it.

New Sunday Mass Time From next **Sunday 7th March**, the parish Sunday Mass will be celebrated at **10am** in church. People can attend Mass if they wish or can follow online at the parish YouTube channel shown above. If numbers attending Sunday Mass increase we will review this Mass time.

For Mass in church please:

- Wear a face covering
- Put a slip of paper with your name and phone number into the box (1 per household)
- Remain 1 metre or more apart
- Sanitise your hands on entry & leaving church
- Leave a 'chair used' sheet on seat
- Do not attend if you have any Covid-19 symptoms
- Do not mingle with another household or bubble inside or outside church.


We had the sad news this week that Ishbel Villiers from Brewood died after a long illness. We keep her and her family in our prayers at this difficult time.

The Apostles' Creed
